This seminar is designed for PhD students in economics with a research interest in macroeconomics / monetary economics. The seminar consists of a lecture taught by Prof. Wright, as well as presentations. Students from all Swiss universities are welcome to participate. The course is suitable for beginning- as well as advanced PhD students. Faculty members are welcome to attend the class and present a paper.

Lecture

The lecture covers various models of money, credit and banking. Prof. Wright will discuss new monetarist models of money, OLG models of money and cash-in-advance (CIA) models. He will then apply these tools to issues of credit and banking.

Presentations

The course participants are offered presentation slots of about 45 minutes (20-30 minutes presentation, and general discussion).
